Rite Click (RI Transition Exploration) is a way to help shape the future for youth with disabilities, between the ages of 16-21, who are preparing to transition to adult life.

The Rite Click principles are:

Individualization

Each student has the help necessary to develop and learn from actively participating in opportunities that match their personal interests.

Community Membership

Each student becomes a valued part of the fabric of local neighborhood life, making the most of the best the neighborhood has to offer.

Natural Supports

Each student gets assistance to actively involve family, friends, neighbors, and co-workers in their success and in learning from challenges.

Increased Independence

Each student gets encouragement and assistance to make choices about their lives and about the kind of help that works best for them.

Rite Click students are invited to explore new possibilities and have conversations about their personal journeys.

Each student and their circles of support will create a Asset Based Portfolio using "Life Building, Opening Windows to Change" by Dr. Beth Mount. Individual work toward developing opportunities will be encouraged and supported between the scheduled events.

Facilitators Doreen McConaghy and Ken Renaud of PAL will lead the process and be available to the students and their circles of support on an as needed basis.
